
INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION AND USE-BASED INDEX FOR TAMIL NADU (BASE 2011-12 = 100)

January 2023 - Final February 2023 - Provisional

The Index of Industrial Production (IIP) with base 2011-12 for the months from January 2023 and February 2023 (Febuary 2023 Provisional) are compiled based on the data received for mining, manufacturing and electricity sectors. The basket of Mining Sector comprises of 8 minerals. Data for mining sector is received from the Department of Geology and Mining, Tamil Nadu. Index for the Manufacturing Sector, at 2 digit and 3 digit NIC has been calculated based on the production particulars received from 1244 factories, for 244 items on a voluntary basis through monthly returns prescribed. For the Electricity sector, the electricity generation data (single item) is obtained from the Central Electricity Authority (CEA).


The weights for Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity sectors are 43.82, 926.59 and 29.59 respectively out of total weight of 1000. Weighing diagram depicted through graphical representation is as follows.

General Index

The General Index for the months of January 2023 (Final) and February 2023 (Provisional) with base year 2011-12 were 139.3 and 141.4 respectively. The cumulative index for the period from April 2022 to February 2023 registered a growth of 9.6 per cent when compared with corresponding period in previous year. This increase was due to the increase in the mining, manufacturing and electricity sectors by 0.7, 10.0 and 7.3 per cent respectively.(Statement 1)

The cumulative index (Apr.'22 to Feb.'23) under manufacturing sector, at NIC-2 digit level, sixteen out of twenty three Industry groups had positive growth when compared with corresponding period in previous year. "Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers", Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery and equipment" having weights 191.79 and 88.63 had growth of 28.3 and 21.0 per cent respectively. (Statement 2.2).

Mining Sector

The Index for the Mining Sector, for the period April 2022 to February 2023 ranges from 79.7 to 113.0. The cumulative index for the period from April 2022 to February 2023 registered a growth of 0.7 per cent when compared with corresponding period in previous year. (Statement 1)

Manufacturing Sector

The Index for the Manufacturing Sector was 140.8 for the month of January 2023 while during the month of February 2023 it increased to 142.4. Even though the index for the month of February 2023 registered a negative growth of (-) 5.9 per cent when compared with February 2022, the cumulative index for the period from April 2022 to February 2023 registered a growth of 10.0 per cent when compared with corresponding period in previous year. (Statement 1)

Out of 58 industry groups in the NIC 3-digit level, during February 2023, 28 industry groups were found to have a positive growth when compared with January 2023. The Growth in the Index during February 2023 (Provisional) when compared with January 2023 is due to the Manufacturing sub groups "Manufacture of motor vehicles" with highest weight of 96.98 increased by 7.1 per cent and "Manufacture of parts and accessories for motor vehicles" with weight 94.8 and "Manufacture of specialpurpose machinery" with weight 28.13 increased by 10.6 and 16.4 per cent respectively. (Statement 3)

Electricity Sector

The cumulative index for the period of April 2022 to February 2023 was 161.2. the same during previous year was 150.2. The cumulative index during 2022-23 had a growth of 7.3 per cent, while it was 18.7 per cent during 2021-22. (Statement 1)



Basic Goods

The cumulative index for the period April 2022 to February 2023 registered a growth of 6.9 per cent when compared with the corresponding period of previous year. During Apr.'22 to Feb.'23 the Index for the Basic goods ranges from 100.7 to 115.0. Peak is noted during the month of July 2022. (Statement 4)

Capital Goods

The Index under the Capital Goods, for the month of February 2023 was 135.6. Even though a gradual decrease is noted in the Index of the Capital Goods which started with 179.5 during April 2022, the cumulative index for the period April 2022 to February 2023 remained the same as that of the previous year with 164.8. (Statement 4).

Intermediate Goods

The Index for the Intermediate Goods during April 2022 was 181.5 The cumulative index for the period April 2022 to February 2023 registered a growth of 22.7 per cent when compared with the corresponding period in previous year. (Statement 4)

Consumer Durable Goods

The Index for the Consumer Durable Goods started with 127.8 during April 2022, it reached its peak during September 2022 with index 231.7. The index gradually decreased to 133.0 during February 2023.(Statement 4)


Consumer Non-Durable Goods

The Index for the Consumer Non-Durable Goods had its peak with 154.3 during April 2022. It ranged from 120.2 to 135.4 during the remaining months. (Statement 4)

Construction Goods

The cumulative index for the period April 2022 to February 2023 registered a growth of 18.5 per cent when compared with the corresponding period in previous year. (Statement 4)

In general, studying the cumulative indices for the period April 2022 to February 2023, except for Capital Goods and Consumer Non-Durable Goods all other use based indices were found to have positive growth when compared with the same period during the previous year. (Statement 4)
